Interested applicants should be agricultural graduates aged between the ages of 18 – 35 years, South African citizen:unemployed graduates who have never participated in an Internship programme or students that require Experiential Training to complete their qualifications. Successful candidates will be exposed to sign an Internship Agreement and they will receive a monthly allowance or stipend which will be determined by the exit level of their qualifications.
